Empty Spaces to Homes Phase 2

We have piloted a groundbreaking solution to the housing crisis, showing how vacant commercial and retail properties can be transformed through retrofitting. In Phase 2, we will explore how scaling this approach can help to address Great Britain's urgent need for affordable housing.

We'll be carrying out research to inform our advocacy work, getting empty spaces on the agenda at local, regional, and national levels, alongside practical projects which create more affordable homes and demonstrate the environmental benefits of exploring alternatives to new construction.

Launching a discounted DIY retail offer in GB, offering households an affordable way to maintain and improve their homes, while raising income to support Habitat's mission.





ReStore

While 4.8 million people in GB are currently “living without” at least one household item, a total of 672,000 tonnes of furniture waste is sent to landfill each year of which almost half could be reused. ReStore contributes to the circular economy, providing essential items at affordable prices

ReStore will house a flagship Community Hub that will facilitate training, employment, volunteer and upcycling opportunities.
